

Glendurgan Socks



Glendurgan is a beautiful garden owned by the National Trust on the coast of Cornwall. The lush green foliage and plants reflect the sub tropical climate that is enjoyed in the far SW of England and these socks are a homage to this beautiful place.

With 'seed heads; and a lovely seed lace pattern the sock is a top down sock with anatomical toes for a good fit.

MATERIALS

100g Camel's Yarn Blue Faced Leicester 4ply Sock Yarn - (400 mtrs)

2.5mm Circular Knitting Needle 80/100cm

2 Stitch Markers (optional)

Tapestry needle

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TENSION (GAUGE)

32 sts and 40/42 rows to 10cm (4ins) over Stocking Stitch or lace pattern on 2.5mm needles or the size required to give correct tension.

Check your tension - if fewer stitches use a smaller needle, if more use a larger needle. IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS. The yarn amounts are based on average requirements when specified tension and yarn is used.

Sizes S (M: L)

To fit shoe size UK 4-6 [6-8:9-11]

Foot circumference 19 (20:21) cms 7¼ [8:8¼] in.

Leg Length 14.5 or 17.5 cm; 5¾ or 6¾ inch

ABBREVIATIONS

beg beginning; cont continue; cm(s) centimetre(s); DPN double pointed needles; foll following; g grams; k knit; k2tog knit two together; in inch(es); inc increase; mm millimetres; p purl; rem remaining; rep repeat; RS right side; rnd(s) round(s); s1 slip one stitch; s1p slip one stitch purlwise; st(s) stitch(es); sm slip marker; pssso pass slipped stitch over; pm place marker; tbl through back of loop; () work instructions within round brackets for your chosen size.

Note

If you are using a small circular needle, you will need DPNs for working the heel flap and when decreasing the toes.

Pattern Notes

Magic loop when working in magic loop method split the stitches so you have half the sts on either side with both sets of sts on the tips.

You simply pull the back needle until you have enough length to knit the sts on the front needle. work across the sts on the front needle. Slide the other set of sts along to the needle just used. Repeat across the other side. You might find it handy to mark the front of your sock with a marker or scrap of yarn.

MORE ADVANCED SOCKS

Socks (both alike)

Using 2.5mm circular needle, cast on 60 [64:68] sts work in rnds place a marker at beg of rnd.

Rnd 1: *K1tbl, P1, rep from * to end of rnd.

Rep last rnd 11 times more.

Purl 4 rnds.

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Flower Head pattern

You will increase stitch to make the flowers only check your stitch count after the flower pattern is complete.

Rnd 1: (P3, yo, K1, yo) 15 [16:17] times.

Rnd 2: (P3, K1, yo, K1, yo, K1) 15 [16:17] times.

Rnd 3: (P3, K2, yo, K1, yo, K2) 15 [16:17] times.

Rnd 4: (P3, K3, yo, K1, yo, K3) 15 [16:17] times.

Rnd 5: (P3, sl1, k1, pssso, K5, K2tog) 15 [16:17] times.

Rnd 6: (P3, sl1, k1, pssso, K3, K2tog) 15 [16:17] times.

Rnd 7: (P3, sl1, k1, pssso, K1, K2tog) 15 [16:17] times.

Rnd 8: (P3, sl1, K2tog, pssso) 15 [16:17] times. 60 [64:68] sts

Rnds 9 to 15: (P3, K1) 15 [16:17] times.

Rnd 16: Knit.

Rnd 17: Purl.

Rnd 18: Knit

Rnd 19: Purl.

Seed Lace

Rnds 1-2: Knit.

Rnd 3: (k2, yfwd, sl1, k1, pssso) 15 [16:17] times.

Rnd 4-8: Knit

Rnd 9: (K2, K2tog, yfwd) 15 [16:17] times.

Rnd 10-12: Knit.

These 12 rnds form Seed lace and are repeated.

Rep these 12 rows once more. (if you prefer longer socks rep the 12 row twice).

Leg should measure 14 cm or 17.5cm now (or continue to your preferred leg length).

Heel

For second sock (left) only k30 [32:34] sts (placing end of rnd edge on the inside leg edge) and proceed as follows:

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Heel flap

Next Row: K30 [32:34] sts, turn. Leave rem 30 [32:34] sts on circular needle.

Working on these 30 [32:34] sts for the heel.

Row 1 (ws): Sl1, (P1, K1) 13 [14:15] times, P3.

Row 2: Sl1, [K1, sl1] 14 [15:16] times, K1.

Rep last 2 rows until heel measures 5 (6:7) cm, ending with a RS row. (should be 9 (11:13) times more)

Turn heel

Row 1(ws): Sl1, P16 [17:18], P2tog, P1, turn.

Row 2: Sl1, K5, sl1, k1, pssso, K1, turn.

Row 3: Sl1, P6, P2tog, P1, turn.

Row 4: Sl1, K7, sl1, k1, pssso, K1, turn.

Row 5: Sl1, P8, P2tog, P1, turn.

Row 6: Sl1, K9, sl1, k1, pssso, K1, turn.

Row 7: Sl1, P10, P2tog, P1, turn.

Row 8: Sl1, K11, sl1, k1, pssso, K1, turn.

Row 9: Sl1, P12, P2tog, P1, turn.

Row 10: Sl1, K13, sl1, k1, pssso, K1, turn.

Row 11: Sl1, P14, P2tog, P1, turn.

Row 12: Sl1, K15, sl1, k1, pssso, K1, turn. 18 [20:22] sts

2nd size

Next Row 13: Sl1, P16, P2tog, turn.

Next Row 14: Sl1, K16, sl1, k1, pssso. turn. 18 sts

3rd size

Next Row 13: Sl1, P16, P2tog, P1, turn.

Next Row 14: Sl1, K17, sl1, k1, pssso, K1, turn 20 sts

All sizes.

Gusset

Note: You will be at the left side of the heel.

Keeping pattern (seed Lace) correct across top of foot be careful to keep the top of foot sts total correct. You will have to miss the last rep on some sizes.

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Set up: Pick up and knit 10 [12:14] sts down left side of heel (1st in each slip st), Place beg of rnd marker, Patt (Rnd 1) across 30 [32:34] sts across sts left on holder, Place marker, pick up and knit 10 [12:14] sts up left side of heel (1st in each slip st), knit across 18 [18:20] sts for heel.
68 [74:82] sts.

Next Part Rnd: Knit to beg of rnd marker.

Remember to keep you seed pattern correct.

Next Rnd: SM, patt 30 [32:34], SM, K1, sl1, k1, pssso, knit to 3sts before marker, k2tog, K1.

66 [72:80] sts.

Next Rnd: SM, patt 30 [32:34], SM, knit to marker.

66 [72:80] sts.

Keeping patt correct, rep last 2 rows 3 [4:6] times more. 60 [64:68] sts

Keeping seed patt correct on top of foot, cont. without shaping until foot measures 16 (17:20.5) cm, 6½ (7:8)in or 6.5 (7:7)cm, 2 ¼ (3:3¼) in less than required foot length.

(you can try your sock on here to check fit)

Shape Toes

For 1st sock (Right)

Magic loop Needle 1 top of foot sts, Needle 2 sole sts.

Rnd 1: K1, sl1, k1, pssso, knit to marker, SM, knit to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1. 58 [62:66] sts

Rnd 2: SM, knit to end, slipping markers.

Rep last 2 rnds 10 times more. 38 [42:46] sts.

Shape both side of toes:

Rnd 1: K1, sl1, k1, pssso, knit to 3 sts before marker, K2tog, K1, SM, K1, sl1, k1, pssso, knit to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1. 34 [38:42] sts.

Rep last rnd 4 [5:5] times more. 22 [22:26] sts.

For 2nd sock (Left)

Magic loop Needle 1 top of foot sts, Needle 2 sole sts.

Rnd 1: K to 3 sts before marker, K2tog, k1, SM, k1, sl1, k1, pssso, knit to end. 58 [62:66] sts

Rnd 2: Sm, knit to end, slipping markers.

Rep last 2 rnds 10 times more. 38 [42:46] sts.

Shape both side of toes

Rnd 1: K1, sl1, k1, pssso, knit to 3 sts before marker, K2tog, K1, SM, K1, sl1, k1, pssso, knit to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1. 34 [38:42] sts.

Rep last rnd 4 [5:5] times more. 22 [22:26] sts.

Glendurgan Socks

For Both Socks

Graft toes using Kitchener stitch or 3 needle cast off.

Weave all ends in. Block to finished measurements

EASY SOCKS

Socks (both alike)

Using 2.5mm circular needle, cast on 60 [64:68] sts work in rnds place a marker at beg of rnd.

Rnd 1: *K1tbl, P1, rep from * to end of rnd. (Jane you can have K1, p1 Here your choice)

Rep last rnd 11 times more.

Purl 4 rnds.

Flower Head pattern

You will increase stitch to make the flowers only check your stitch count after the flower pattern is complete.

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Rnd 2: (P3, K1, yo, K1, yo, K1) 15 [16:17] times.

Rnd 3: (P3, K2, yo, K1, yo, K2) 15 [16:17] times.

Rnd 4: (P3, K3, yo, K1, yo, K3) 15 [16:17] times.

Rnd 5: (P3, sl1, k1, pssso, K5, K2tog) 15 [16:17] times.

Rnd 6: (P3, sl1, k1, pssso, K3, K2tog) 15 [16:17] times.

Rnd 7: (P3, sl1, k1, pssso, K1, K2tog) 15 [16:17] times.

Rnd 8: (P3, sl1, K2tog, pssso) 15 [16:17] times. 60 [64:68] sts

Rnds 9 to 15: (P3, K1) 15 [16:17] times.

Rnd 16: Knit.

Rnd 17: Purl.

Rnd 18: Knit

Rnd 19: Purl.

Knit 24 rnds or until leg measures 14cm.

Heel flap

Next Row: K30 [32:34] sts, turn. Leave rem 30 [32:34] sts on circular needle.

Working on these 30 [32:34] sts for the heel.

Row 1 (ws): Sl1, (P1, K1) 13 [14:15] times, P3.

Row 2: Sl1, [K1, s1p] 14 [15:16] times, K1.

Rep last 2 rows until heel measures 5 (6:7) cm, ending with a RS row. (should be 9 (11:13) times more)

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Turn heel

Row 1(ws): Sl1, P16 [17:18], P2tog, P1, turn.

Row 2: Sl1, K5, sl1, k1, pssso, K1, turn.

Row 3: Sl1, P6, P2tog, P1, turn.

Row 4: Sl1, K7, sl1, k1, pssso, K1, turn.

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2nd size

Next Row 13: Sl1, P16, P2tog, turn.

Next Row 14: Sl1, K16, sl1, k1, pssso. turn. 18 sts

3rd size

Next Row 13: Sl1, P16, P2tog, P1, turn.

Next Row 14: Sl1, K17, sl1, k1, pssso, K1, turn 20 sts

All sizes.

Gusset

Pick up and knit 10 [12:14] sts down left side of heel (1st in each slip st), Place beg of rnd marker, knit across 30 [32:34] sts across sts left on holder, Place marker, pick up and knit 10 [12:14] sts up left side of heel (1st in each slip st), knit across 18 [18:20] sts for heel.

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Next Rnd: SM, K30 [32:34], SM, K1, sl1, k1, pssso, knit to 3sts before marker, k2tog, K1.

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Next Rnd: SM, K30 [32:34], SM, knit to marker.

66 [72:80] sts.

Rep last 2 rows 3 [4:6] times more. 60 [64:68] sts

Cont without shaping until foot measures 16 (17:20.5) cm, 6½ (7:8)in or 6.5 (7:7)cm, 2 ¼ (3:3¼) in less than required foot length.

(you can try your sock on here to check fit)

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Magic loop Needle 1 top of foot sts, Needle 2 sole sts.

Rnd 1: K1, sl1, k1, pssso, knit to marker, SM, knit to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1. 58 [62:66] sts

Rnd 2: SM, knit to end, slipping markers.

Rep last 2 rnds 10 times more. 38 [42:46] sts.

Shape both side of toes

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Rep last rnd 4 [5:5] times more. 22 [22:26] sts.

For 2nd sock (Left)

Magic loop Needle 1 top of foot sts, Needle 2 sole sts.

Rnd 1: K to 3 sts before marker, K2tog, k1, SM, k1, sl1, k1, pssso, knit to end. 58 [62:66] sts

Rnd 2: Sm, knit to end, slipping markers.

Rep last 2 rnds 10 times more. 38 [42:46] sts.

Shape both side of toes

Rnd 1: K1, sl1, k1, pssso, knit to 3 sts before marker, K2tog, K1, SM, K1, sl1, k1, pssso, knit to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1. 34 [38:42] sts.

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
